What is a temple? —

HOLINESS TO THE LORD

Since ancient times, temples, known as the “house of the Lord” have been built to worship God.

Temples are sacred and are the place to unite families. Temples are different from chapels where we get together to worship on Sundays. Temples are places to perform wedding and various ordinances for our ancestors.

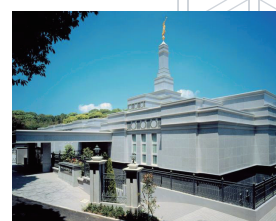
Marriages performed in the temple are not “till death do us part” but continue beyond this life and into the eternities.

As of April 2022, there are a total of 282 temples, including 162 in operation, under construction, under renovation, or with announced construction sites.

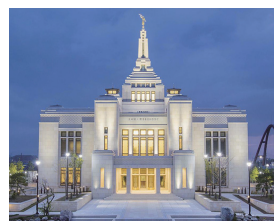

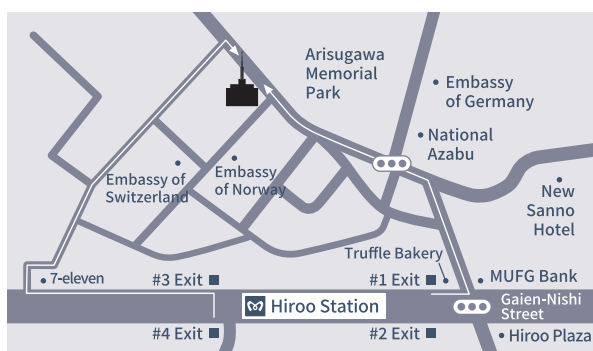
